


## AN EASTER MESSAGE OF HOPE

## An alternative compensation initiative for dispossessed farmers and agricultural rebuilding strategy

It is 23 years since the brutal farm invasions began in Zimbabwe, triggering the country's chaotic downward spiral, with the food security crisis affecting millions and catastrophic economic decline.

Despite the ongoing chaos in Zimbabwe, there are signs of hope.

For example, the Southern African Agri Initiative (SAAI) is now assisting our dispossessed Zimbabwean farmers, many of whom are destitute, with an alternative compensation and agricultural rebuilding strategy. SAAI is the South Africa-based agricultural interest network which is "for farmers by farmers". It is committed to protecting and promoting the rights, values, ideals and needs of family farmers regionally in the primary production sector.

Without the resolution of compensation and property rights for expropriated farms according to international law, and restoration of the rule of law in Zimbabwe, the crucial agricultural sector cannot be rebuilt.

#### Our planned guest speakers will be:

**Dr. Theo de Jager:** Chairman of the Southern African Agri Initiative (SAAI). He was president of the World Farmers' Organisation from 2017-2019, which represents farmers in over 80 countries around the world. He is a farmer, as well as a qualified lawyer and valuator and has played a pivotal role in agriculture in South Africa, Africa and internationally since 1997.

**Hopewell Chin'ono:** An award-winning documentary filmmaker and international journalist. He has worked for ITV News, The New York Times and the BBC World Service. He has received numerous awards and is one of the most courageous men we know, constantly facing jail and worse at the hands of the Zimbabwe government.

Advocate Fadzayi Mahere: A prominent Zimbabwean lawyer who currently serves as the National Spokesperson for the main opposition party, the Citizens Coalition for Change. Fadzayi is one of the bravest women we know. Having obtained a Master of Laws (LLM) degree, she went on to get an LLM in International Criminal Law and International Commercial Litigation at the University of Cambridge. She worked for a year at the International Criminal Court in The Hague. As a lawyer she is often in court defending others, but she finds herself in the criminal dock frequently, being charged criminally for speaking out against injustice.

Ben Freeth MBE has continued to stand for justice wherever he can, particularly against the injustice that continues to be perpetrated in the agricultural sector. Ben has also been persecuted by the authorities, including being beaten up very badly on a number of occasions. He is desperate to see Zimbabwean agriculture rebuilt, with property rights established throughout the region.

**Baroness Kate Hoey:** We are very honoured to have Baroness Kate Hoey chairing the event. She is a wonderful ambassador for the suffering people of Zimbabwe. She has travelled bravely to the country on many occasions, sometimes undercover, and has experienced several threats of arrest from the Zimbabwe Government.

We hope to have another honoured guest who will join the panel for questions.

## Al Jazeera's remarkable exposé of a top-level gold smuggling network from Zimbabwe to Dubai

"The Gold Mafia", Al Jazeera's 4-part undercover investigation into gold smuggling, reveals in Part 1: "The Laundry Service" how billions of dollars' worth of gold is smuggled from Zimbabwe to Dubai, allowing criminals to clean dirty money through a web of shell companies, invoices and paid-off officials. A senior Zimbabwean ambassador offers to launder US\$1.2 million using the cover of his diplomatic bag. At the centre of their operations is southern Africa's biggest "Laundromat", the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe.
